Easy Hanging Frame Hair Clippie Holder



This Hair Clippie Holder is easy & inexpensive to make

You'll need an old frame (no glass). They're easy to find at thrift stores or garage sales.
Mine's an 11" x 14"
Batting – polyester
Fabric
Ribbon

I had an old frame lying around. I sanded it a bit and spray painted it black.



If you're frame doesn't have a cardboard back on it, cut one to fit.
Use a thicker cardboard or foamcore board.

Cut a piece of polyester batting to fit the cardboard back.
I secured mine with spray adhesive.

Cut a piece of fabric at least 1" bigger all around than the cardboard back.
Iron the fabric and place it right side down.
Put the back piece with the batting centered on top of the fabric – batting side down.

Bring the sides of the fabric around to the back. I secured the edges with packaging tape.
It will all get covered up in the end ☺
Make sure the fabric is tight.



I used 3 pieces of 3/8" ribbon and spaced the out along the length of the fabric covered piece on the front side.
Secure the ends on the back with packaging tape.
Place the fabric covered piece in the frame.



I wanted to hang the frame with ribbon.
I cut a length of 1.50" ribbon and placed it on the back.
I used a staple gun to secure the ribbon into the wood frame.
See arrows below.



Cut a piece of thin cardboard to fit into the back of the frame.
This frame had metal tabs to bend over to hold it in.
I will also staple it into the wooden frame.



Snap your clippies onto the ribbons on the front.
