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Reen's Monogram Flower Flip Flops



Make these cute flower flip flops in minutes

You will need my **Fringed Flower Button Cover Alphabet**
This set is free from my Machine Embroidery Ad List

Follow the instructions and create 2 Fringed Flower covered buttons
Use the buttons to cover that have the shanks on them, not the flat backs.

You will need the following:

1 pair of flip flops

Silk Flowers

2 rubber pony tail holders (pony-O's)



Pull the flowers apart.

I mixed the 2 colors of petals for mine.

Layer the petals how you want them to look.

I have 6-7 layers in each of mine.



From the right side, push the shank of the button through the holes in the petal sections



Insert the pony-O through the shank as shown below. It's a bit tight. You can use a pin or something to help you pull it through.



Put the large end through the small end and pull it tightly.

Now you have to attach the flower to the flip flop.
Place the flower on top. Wrap the pony-O down and around the post counterclockwise.
Pull the loop up and over the flower.
This should secure it nicely.

It's hard to get a photo of this, but the one below shows the steps.
The flower is sitting on top of the "Y" of the flip flop.
The pony-O comes down to the right and goes under the post.
It comes back up and over the top of the flower.



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
