# Supplies I Used

- Quilting Cuddle – new low-pile Minky from Shannon Fabrics
- Serger or sewing machine
- Kai Serrated Scissors
- Seam Ripper
- Something to trace your hoodie pattern



# Overview

- Deconstruct a hoodie to use as a pattern
- Trace a pattern from the pieces
- Create a new patchwork of fabrics
- Optional: Embellish with embroidery, etc.
- Cut out a new pattern
- Serge or machine sew the pieces together
- In the Hoop Sweatshirt Pocket File



# Homework

- Get a hoodie – or use an old one you have
- Suitable material to trace your pattern
- Gather fabrics you want to use for your patchwork
- Start thinking about your layout
- Test settings on your Serger or sewing machine
- ITH Sweatshirt Pocket File from Embroidery Garden on sale
