

HOODIE MAKE OVER – Part 3

- Cutting out the pattern from your patchwork
- Cutting out the hood
- Eyelets for drawstring
- Topstitch or not?
- Sewing or Serging
- Set in Sleeve or Stitch Cuff to Hem



Overview



- Cut out front, back, 2 sleeves and hood
- Install eyelets in hood. Go over stitching hood
- Topstitch?
- Sewing the hoodie together. I would use a 3/8" seam. Finishing the seam allowances?
- Serging the hoodie together. Barely trim edge.
- 2 ways to do the sleeves – Stitch sleeve to shoulder or set sleeve in.

Homework

- Stitch front to back.
- Stitch in sleeves
- Stitch hood and attach
